Post 245 Color Guard wants YOU!Need to back fill the ranks of our Color Guard. We have lost a number of our Guard members (deceased or disabled) over the last 5 years. Post 245 is a Certified Funeral Honors provider. As such, we are called on to do military funeral rites for the greater Dane County/Madison area for any eligible veteran, Legionnaire or not. With our current roster of Color Guard members, we are not able to fill the ranks for a funeral. A full funeral detail includes: (1) Commander, (1) Chaplain, (2) Flag bearers, (2) Flag guards-rifles, (2) Flag folding, (1) Sgt at Arms, (7) Rifles for salute, (1) Bugler for taps. Total of 17 Legionnaires. Fortunately, the military now does the Flag folding - but not always. Other short staff measures we use are one person does Commander/Chaplain, no rifle guards on the flags, have less than 7 for rifle salute. We are also short for the Memorial Day program at the Legion, since several of the Guard members are also the Officers on stage who are doing the rest of the program.
